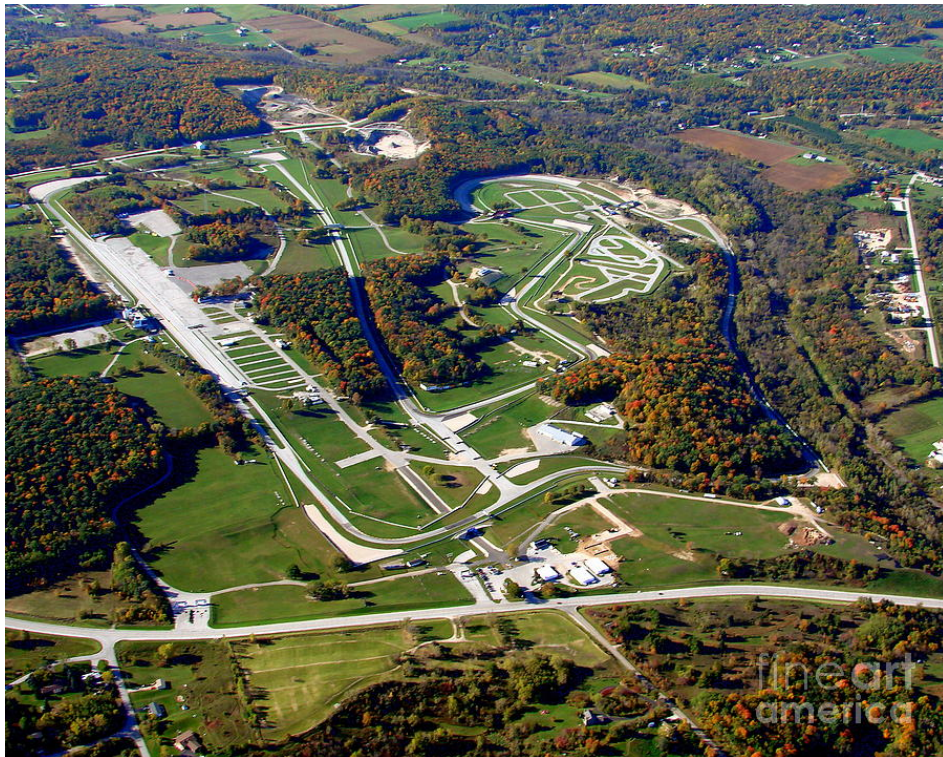

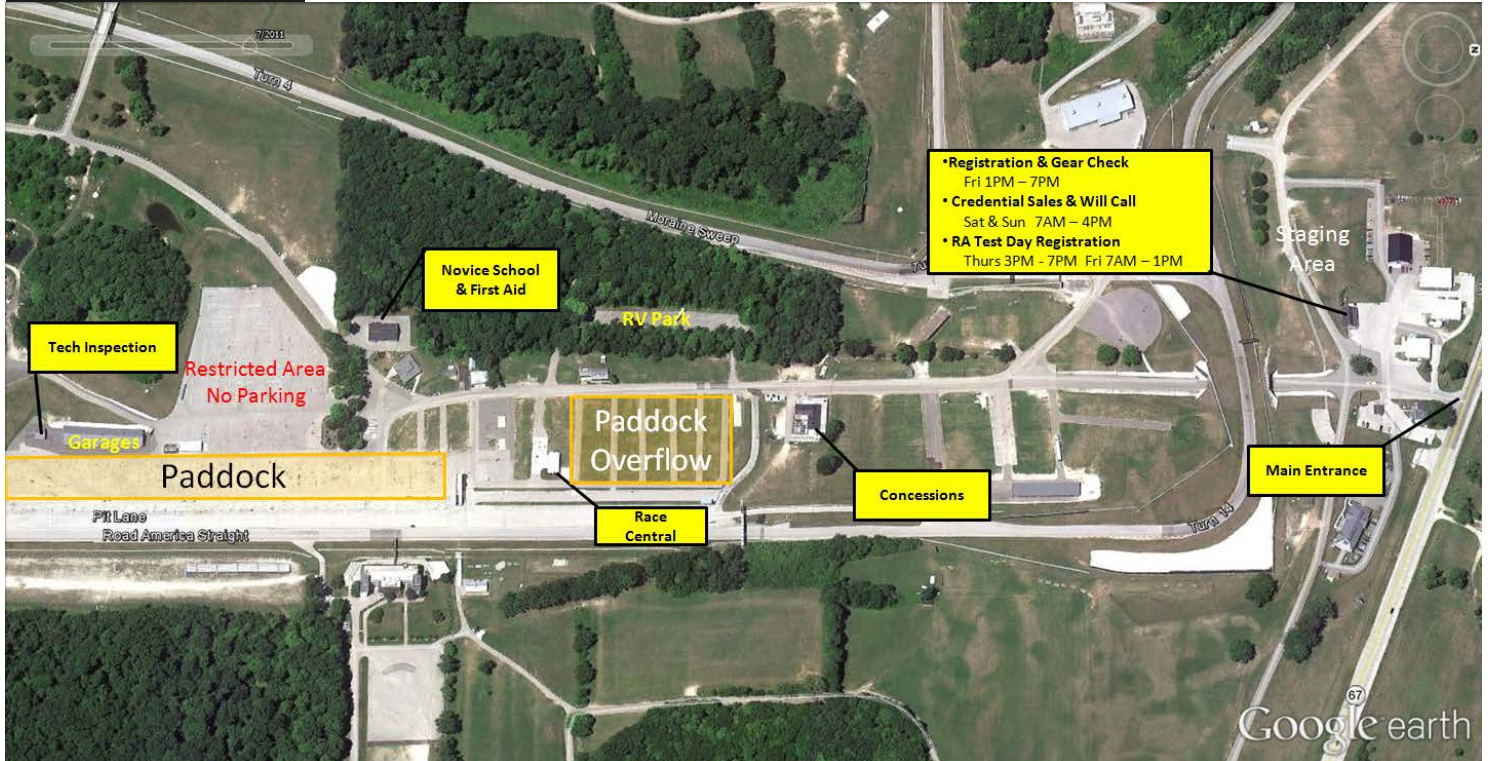

Road America Test Day! (from Road America):

Registration for the ChumpCar World Series TEST DAY (04/15/2016) will be open **Thursday, 04/14/2016, 3P-7P** and **Friday, 04/15/2016, 7AM-1PM**. **ALL** drivers participating in the Test Day must be a registered participant in the ChumpCar World Series and all drivers and crew will be asked to sign Road America's waiver to collect Test Day credentials. You will also be asked to sign ChumpCar's waiver and receive your event wristband. Once you have completed Registration, you will be allowed access to the Paddock and Garages. Please note there is NO tech for our test day. Registration is located in the Nationwide Registration building located inside Gate 6. **Cost:** \$300

Gates Open for Test Day Entrants ONLY

If you are NOT participating in Road America's Test Day you will NOT be allowed to enter the paddock until 3 PM on Friday. You may park your vehicles in the staging area next to the registration building if you arrive early. Everyone entering the track Thursday for the Test Day will be issued a waiver wristband by Road America after you sign both waivers. You must keep this wristband on for the entire weekend in addition to your Driver or Crew wristband. All teams not participating in the Test Day will be required to go through ChumpCar registration before they can enter the track, this is where you will receive your required waiver wristband and your Driver or Crew band.

ALL drivers and crew must report to the ticket window at registration to sign the waiver and receive a waiver wristband. You will not be allowed access to the track without this wristband. Only the team captain needs to check in at registration to receive driver and crew credentials.

There will no Tech Inspection on Saturday. If you have a problem making tech inspection call Mike Morrison at 214-738-6072 ASAP.

Teams must print all Safety & Tech Inspection forms before arrival and fill-out all forms before entering the tech line. Teams are also highly advised to have a itemized list declaring all performance modifications to their race car using the points system in the 2016 BCR.

Registration and Gear Check will open at 2pm in the registration building shown below. Anyone entering the track must stop by the registration building to sign the waiver before they will be allowed through the tunnel at 3pm. Please use the staging area to park your trailer while you go through registration and get the waiver signed.

Paddock spots located in front of the garages are reserved for teams that are renting garages. We will do our best to get you in to the paddock spot located next to your pit stall. Please keep parking tight and orderly.

Pit, Paddock and Garage Supplemental Rules:

- **SR1** - Pit lane spaces will be assigned in registration.
- **SR2** - No crew members are allowed over the wall until the car has come to a complete stop in the pit box.
- **SR3** - The Hot Pit Lane will be the exclusive fueling area. Fueling of race cars shall be completed by use of 5-gallon plastic jugs and funnels, hoses or other fueling adapters as specified in the ChumpCar BCR. Jugs must have sealable lids/caps. Metal fuel drums or other fuel containers and caddies with manual pumps (no electric pumps) and hose lines are allowed to re-fill plastic jugs but are not allowed for re-fueling race cars, unless specified in the ChumpCar BCR. All fuel storage must be maintained on the "cold" side of the pit wall or kept within your transporter.
- **SR4** - All teams shall have one (1) fully-charged 10LB ABC fire extinguisher in their pit area. All teams shall have one (1) 10LB bag of kitty litter or other reasonable absorbent for oil leaks and/or fuel spillage in their pit area. Having a broom handy is also advisable.
- **SR5** - Drivers may remain in the car during fueling and driver changes may also be completed. All engines and electrical kill switches must be off during fueling. **NO WORK ON YOUR CAR SHALL BE COMPLETED DURING REFUELING. 5 PEOPLE OVER THE WALL MAX DURING REFUELING.**
- **SR6** - All work and/or repairs that can be made to your race cars in under thirty (30) minutes may be executed in the Pit Lane; all repairs requiring more than 30 minutes time must be completed in the Garage Area or Paddock. A penalty of 1 lap for every five (5) minutes of work in the pit lane that exceeds 30 minutes shall be levied.
- **SR7** - All team members over the wall during fueling must wear a Nomex driver's suit, gloves and full-face helmet with their visor down.
- **SR8** - No open flame stoves or BBQs are allowed in the cold pits.
- **SR9** - All cars, used or junk parts too big for a normal trash can, empty fuel drums and anything else you brought with you must be taken out with you.

Pit Passes – Spectators and Guests: Teams are advised that any and all team members, family, guests who desire event access **MUST** purchase a Pit Pass through ChumpCar. These are available in registration. They will also be for sale at the ticket counter Sat 8am-4pm and Sun 8am-2pm.

Overnight Camping: RV camping in the paddock is allowed on Friday and Saturday night. Contact Road America for details. 920-892-4576

Garages: Garages are available for rent. Contact Road America for details. 920-892-4576

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the transporter parking area and thirty feet (30') outside the cold pit area, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Concessions: The Gear Box concession stand will be open for the event.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.
